



About Stronger Together

Stronger Together is an Erasmus+ project that aim to improve awareness, dialogues, and inclusion among pupils, teachers, and parents, in order to prevent radicalization in schools. The project targets teachers who teach pupils in the age: 10-12 years old, pupils of this age, and their parents. Period: September 2018 to October 2020.

Objective

The main objective of the project is to give the pupils', teachers', and parents' a sense of being "Stronger Together", especially in the process of preventing and combating radicalization in schools.

The project develops a Stronger Together Curriculum consisting of five modules and a digital board game. The modules focus on: Morality, Self-Control, Inclusion & Diversity, Critical Thinking, and Prevention of Radicalization, because these skills and values have proven essential to prevent exclusion, criminalization, and violent extremism.

The curriculum combines traditional learning with the digital board game, where pupils and parents will play together and through activities in the game, they will reflect upon dilemmas and train their competences in the mentioned themes.
